## **REACH SVHC Declaration of Conformity**

Finkelstein Metals Ltd. hereby declares that, of the date of issuance of this declaration, all products supplied by the company are assessed in accordance with the requirements of the REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006, specifically Article 33 – Obligation to communicate information on substances in articles.

According to Article 33, any supplier of an article containing a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) in a concentration above 0.1% by weight (w/w) at the homogeneous material level must provide recipients with sufficient information to allow safe use of the article, including at least the name of the substance.
